What is Children's Church?

Children's Church is a worship service designed specifically for children in Kindergarten – 3rd grade.

What can my child expect?

We will praise and worship Jesus with live music, experiential prayer, interactive Bible stories, small group conversations, activities, and, oh yes, a snack to fuel our bodies as we fuel our souls.

At St. Luke's, third grade is a BIG milestone year! We want to help them explore and experience the Bible in depth as they prepare to receive their own personalized Bible in January. After praise music and experiential prayer, the 3rd graders will break off to ***Bible Blast!*** for the remainder of the hour.

Will Children's Church meet every Sunday? We will meet on most Sundays, including nine Sundays through the end of the year (no Children's Church on 11/25, 12/23 and 12/30). Look for 2019 dates in early December. After Care (games and activities in the Loft) will be available on the Sundays when Children's Church does not meet.



Why Children's Church? As one body in Christ, we celebrate the variety of experiences we offer children and their families to grow in their faith at St. Luke's.

Many families already worship with their children in contemporary or traditional worship. We love family worship! Children's Church provides another opportunity to foster the love of Jesus as we learn more about Jesus' teaching, community worship, serving others in the name of Jesus, the sacraments, as well as offer additional family conversations at home.
